On the 16<sup>th</sup> of September 2018 we will be once again holding the Aldeburgh Triathlon in aid of the RNLI and East Anglian Air Ambulance.

To assist in running a safe and successful event we have applied for permission to once again close Market Cross Place and put in place a temporary one way system on “Thorpe road” between Wentworth road and Church Farm road.

The closure and traffic re-direction mimics that put during the event in 2017 and continues to retain access to all residential properties and businesses so long as installed diverted traffic signage is followed.

This closure and change to traffic flow will be in place from 9am until 4pm on the day and removed as soon as possible following completion of the event to minimise the impact on the local residents and businesses

To further help the smooth running of the event we ask that you support us by not parking your vehicles within the areas indicated (see reverse) prior to the road closure being enforced at 9:00am on the 16<sup>th</sup>.

Any vehicles which remain inside the road closure will be trapped for the duration of the event and will heavily affect our ability to run this charity fundraising event.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your co-operation and support.

## Road closure proposal to support Aldeburgh Triathlon 16/09/18

The below map details our proposed road closure and traffic management plan. The section marked in **RED** is to be closed for vehicular access for the duration of the closure.

The section marked in **BLUE** will be used as a one way system travelling south to north to eliminate traffic congestion where Church Farm road meets Thorpe road (north end of one way system). The South bound section of Thorpe road highlighted in Blue will be sectioned off seeing only cyclists travelling South upon it.

All traffic travelling from the North to the South down Thorpe road will be directed into Church Farm Road and allowed to access the town by taking Victoria Road.
