1. **Apologies:** There were no apologies.
2. **Approval of Previous Minutes**
Cllr Palmer commended the draft Minutes of the Services Committees meeting held on 23 May 2016 for **APPROVAL** without amendment. The Minutes were duly signed.
3. **Matters for Discussion – SCC, SCDC and Police**
A number of issues were ongoing including future levels of police resourcing for Aldeburgh and the re-surfacing of Thorpe Road car park, but there were no new outcomes to report.
- 3.1 **Museum Update**
Cllr Fox was invited to give an update on progress with the HLF grant application. She explained that the Museum Trustees will be meeting with the Quantity Surveyor on 5 July, the HLF grant application is on track for submission in August and the Museum Trustees have agreed to create a temporary exhibition during 2017 to commemorate the Elizabeth Garrett-Anderson centenary. The Cllrs had a brief discussion to consider where the exhibition might be located and suggested the robe cupboard could be moved to create additional space.
