 Proposal: 2no. Sycamore (T1 and T2 on plan) Crown reduce by 2 metres

Cllr Haworth-Culf in her capacity as SCC councillor has received an email from Mr Marriott regarding Fishing Hut 3. She has replied stating that SCC do not have any jurisdiction over the renting of the Fishing Huts and advised him to contact East Suffolk Council who have served the Section 20 notice order.

Mr Marriot has until 31st March 2024 to respond to ESC.

ATC maintain a view that Mr Marriot did not abide by rules and regulations that apply to all other catering establishments. It is unfair to the other fishermen for this to have been allowed to continue for so long. From the very start the tenant should have consulted ESC and the previous tenant not been permitted to pass on the lease.

Cllrs discussed the need for ESC representation at committee level. This area is not presently represented and includes the many NSIPs. **ACTION** – Cllr Fox will investigate further by contacting Cllr Whitelock (ESC).

6. To receive, consider and resolve if applicable, any new or existing enforcement activity.

Aldeburgh Planning Committee are very concerned about trees and hedges being cut and burnt on Aldeburgh Golf Course. We do not believe these are part of any planning permission given.

On the 14th hole area at least two mature oak trees have been felled and burnt. It is believed that bat boxes and owl boxes have been removed.
